
Deadwood

⊘ Dos & **⊘** Don'ts

What is the best way to create a deadwood pile?





Loosely stack branches, trunks and twigs in a crisscross pattern to create sufficient hollow spaces.



Leave deadwood lying around for several years so that the natural decomposition processes can take place in all stages up to the formation of mulch and humus.



Do not let the deadwood pile become completely overgrown.



Do not pile deadwood in a cavity: too much water can collect in the cavity.



Do not use cuttings from exotic ornamental hedges.
